WHOLE CHILD EDUCATION

Rationale

NAG 1 requires schools to develop and make known to the school community policies, plans and targets for improving the achievement of Maori students. This is to be done in consultation with the Maori Community.

Purpose

1. To consult with the local iwi and parents of Maori children in the school to ascertain their aspirations for their children.
2. To document plans and targets for improving the achievement of Maori students.

Guidelines

1. The school will hold a hui or survey parents of Maori students each year to discuss and consult on the school's plan for Maori students.
2. Teachers will meet individually with parents of Maori children at scheduled interview and reporting time to discuss the achievement of their children.
3. During school wide student achievement data reviews, the report to the Board will include data and recommendations on the achievement of our Maori students.
4. Budget and curriculum provisions to reflect the identified needs of Maori students.

Approval

When the Board approved this Policy it agreed that no variations of this Policy or amendments to it can be made except with approval of the Board. A copy of this policy is to be included in the School Policy Manual, a copy of which shall be available to all staff, and to students and parents at their request.
