## Uniform Policy

### Purpose

The Board of Trustees believe the following benefits are derived from having a school uniform:

- Children have an instant sense of belonging to the school
- Children have a pride in their appearance
- The school has instant recognition within the community
- An identity with the school is nurtured

### Guidelines

Student uniforms must be maintained in a presentable manner. The uniform should conform to the list below and may be purchased through the school or an approved supplier. All school uniform items must have the school logo.

- **Polo Shirt** - Jade (short or long sleeved)
- **Culottes** - Navy
- **Cargo Shorts** - Navy
- **Sweatshirt** - Navy
- **Sun Hat** - Navy, bucket style or cap
- **Socks** - White, Navy or Black
- **Shoes** - As set out below

### Optional

- **Cargo Trousers** - Navy (long)
- **Girls Boot Leg Trousers** - Navy (note, no logo in this item)
- **Polar Fleece Tunic** - Navy (half front zip)
- **Rain Jacket** - Navy (lined with full zip)
- **Girls Tights** - Navy

**Shoes** - Students must wear flat sensible footwear for school, either sturdy sandals or running shoes (lace up or velcro). No crocs, jandals or boots.

### Sports Uniform

All students who participate in extra-curricular sport must purchase a sport uniform through an approved supplier which is suitable for that sport.

- **Sports T-shirt** - Jade/ Navy
- **Sports Singlet** - Jade/ Navy
- **Sports Shorts** - Navy
- **Netball Skort** - Navy

When the Board approved this Policy it agreed that no variations of this Policy or amendments to it can be made except with the approval of the Board.
