OUR LEARNING

Welcome back to term 2! We hope you all enjoyed the holiday break. Here is an outline of what's on this term in Rimu team:

For the first two weeks of term students will be attending swimming lessons daily at Northern Arena. You are welcome to come and watch your child's lesson. Please make sure they have the correct gear packed everyday.

This term for topic we will be focusing on Science and Technology. Students will learn about the Scientific method through participating in a range of experiments. We will be investigating magnetism, electricity, forces and chemistry.

For literacy students will continue with our structured literacy programme. This involves daily practise of encoding and decoding words. Students practise handwriting regularly to improve letter formation. They will also be working on improving their fluency and beginning to read with expression. To support this, we encourage you to read with your child at home for enjoyment. We will also be learning about instructional writing.

In mathematics we will be continuing to work on basic facts and addition and subtraction strategies. For strand we will be learning about measurement; specifically length, weight and time.

For physical education students will be working on their fitness and stamina in preparation for cross country. We will also be working on developing a variety of ball skills; throwing, catching and kicking.
